History Repeats Itself

We can now add fraud schemes to the list of things adhering to Johnathan Swift's centuries-old idiom, "Everything old is new again". It seems that not unlike fanny packs and high-waisted denim, mail theft and check washing are en vogue once more.

Hopefully you have seen recent stories that mail is being stolen across the state and the nation. It has happened in your town, although it may not have been reported by the media. Recently thieves stole mail from the large blue mailboxes right in front of the Glastonbury post office.

Fraudsters are also back to washing checks. What is check washing? Thieves

intercept your check, remove the writing, and then re-write the check to one of their payees for a larger dollar amount.

Mail theft and washing of checks are connected. Years ago these schemes were prevalent, which is why people were warned not to raise the red flag on their mailbox, as it broadcasted to fraudsters which boxes had outgoing mail and likely checks paying bills. Mail theft and check washing fell out of fashion for fraudsters, who seemed to be evolving towards digital schemes, but now these old-fashioned, low-fi standards are back in rotation and are occurring at alarming rates.

Vigilance is key. Try and minimize the number of checks you write, regularly monitor your bank account activity, bring your mail to the post office, or deposit it into a blue mailbox in a busy area just prior to the posted picked time. These measures will help you lessen the risks with mail theft and check washing.
